

Art & Music Activity

We will be listening to four pieces of music from the collection, <u>Carnival of the Animals</u> by Camille Saint Saens. Each of his pieces were written using music to describe an animal. I will post Mr. Saint Saens' animal choices on Friday to give you a chance to come up with your own.

<u>Supplies:</u> blank white drawing paper, pencil, device to hear the music, crayons/colored pencils if you want to

Activity:

- Fold paper into ¼'s making 4 squares on your page.
- Number each square 1-4
- Listen to each song and decide which animal you think Mr. Saint Saens was describing.
 (Song #1: draw animal in box #1)
- Draw your animal, leaving space at the bottom of each box to write down what you heard that made you pick your animal. (Pitches, mood, loud/soft, fast/slow, sad/happy)
- Email me a picture of your animals, I would love to see which animals you picked!

**Hint: you will need to use your imagination; you will not hear the "roaring" of a lion or the "quacking" of a duck!
